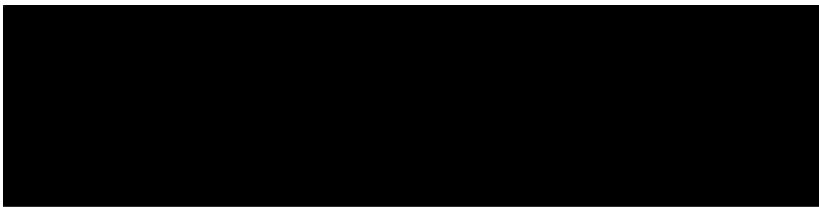


CERTIFICATE

The company



is granted authorisation according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark, based on our test report **1873/2021**



for the following articles:

Short sleeves t-shirts (Ref. Sofia, Luanda, Ankara, Ankara Women, Ankara Kids, Quito, san Marino), long sleeves t-shirts (Ref. Bucharest, Bucharest Women), polo-shirts (Ref. Eve, Bern, Bern Women, Adam, Adam Kids, Rome, Rome Women, Monaco, Dhaka), tops (Ref. Tirana, Ibiza), V-neck t-shirts (Ref. Athens, Athens Women), in white and dyed knitted fabrics in 100% Cotton.

Woven jackets (soft shell) in Polyester/Elastane.

Including embroidering applications and the accessories: sewing and embroidery threads, interlinings, cords, buttons, zippers, plastic stoppers, metallic accessories, elastics, satin tapes, twill tapes, velcro tapes, woven and printed labels. (Articles already STANDARD 100 pre-certified).

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.

The certificate 6198CIT is valid until 28.02.2022
