

User's manual – Patina big and small

1. Unscrew the burner. Fill the lamp with high quality lamp oil. Please make sure the container is well-filled before using it the first time. However, do not fill it to the absolute top as it might then overflow when you screw the burner back on. (Max. 0.7 liters for Patina Small, and 1.5 liters for Patina Big).
2. Let the wick absorb the oil. Screw it up and dip it in the oil upside down first for a few minutes. This will make the process quicker. Then screw it back on and leave it for another 15 minutes to make sure it is soaked all the way through.
3. For a nice and even flame a straight edged wick is preferable. Adjust if necessary.
4. When lighting the oil lamp the wick should be 1-2 millimeters over the burner's edge. It should never be adjusted higher than this in order to avoid the actual wick itself from burning. In this case you would have to change the wick regularly since it would become shorter and shorter. That is not how it is meant to be used. Also make sure that there is always a little oil left in the container so that the wick does not get dry.
